Mycorrhizal Fungal Transplant Inoculant

Mycor™ Tree Saver™ Transplant is used to treat the root zones of trees and shrubs with beneficial mycorrhizal fungi, water absorbent hydrogels and organic soil conditioners at planting time. This product contains both vesicular-arbuscular mycorrhizal (VAM) and (*Pisolithus tinctorius*) ectomycorrhizal fungi that form mycorrhizae and colonize the roots of most species of newly planted trees and shrubs in a broad range of growing conditions. In addition to the mycorrhizal fungi, this product contains Terra-Sorb™ hydrogels, natural humates, yucca plant and seaweed extracts.

STORAGE/SHELF LIFE

Shelf Life – 24 Months: This product is stable in cool, dry storage conditions for up to 24 months, and possibly longer if refrigerated. **Do not expose to direct sunlight.**

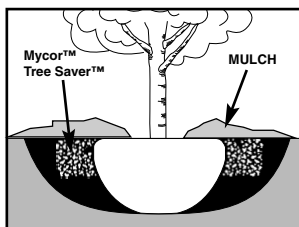

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use 1 packet (3-oz.) for each 1-foot (30-cm) diameter of root ball.

1. Place the tree/shrub in planting hole and backfill soil 3” to 4” (8-10cm) from top of root ball.
2. Evenly spread contents of packet(s) in “doughnut shaped” ring up to 8” (20-cm) wide around the outside edge of the root ball.
3. Backfill remaining 3” to 4” (8-10cm) of soil.
4. Thoroughly mix area around edge of root ball up to 8” (20cm) wide to a depth of 8”(20cm).
5. Pack firmly.
6. Mulch.
7. Water to soil saturation.



Note: For best results, use with Healthy Start™ biofertilizer tablets.

COMPATIBILITY

Species: Mycor™ Tree Saver™ is effective for all tree and shrub species except Rhododendrons, Azaleas, and Mountain Laurels, which require ericoid mycorrhizae.

Soil pH: The fungi in this product were chosen based on their ability to survive and colonize plant roots in a broad pH range of 3.0 - 8.0.

Fungicides: The use of certain fungicides can have a detrimental effect on your inoculation program. Soil application of any fungicide is not recommended for two weeks after application. Call PHC Technical Services at 1-800-421-9051 for additional information on fungicides.

Other pesticides: Herbicides and Insecticides do not normally interfere with mycorrhizal fungal development, but may inhibit the growth of some tree and shrub species if not used properly.

LANDSCAPE PLANTING INSTRUCTIONS (For Groundcover, Perennials, Roses, Shrubs, Vines and Trees)

1. Dig planting hole to recommended depth.
2. Backfill hole to attain proper level for the plant.
3. Place recommended tablet(s) in the upper 2" of planting hole. Space the tablets equally around the perimeter of the rootball approximately 2" from the root tips.
4. Finish backfilling the planting hole, tamping the soil firmly and water thoroughly.

BALLED AND BURLAPPED OR BARERoot PLANTS

Use equivalent number of tablets that would correspond to container size—or measure stem 14" above soil level, then for each 1/2" caliper use 1-2 (21) gram tablets or 3-4 (7) gram tablets. Follow the same planting procedure as above, except place tablets directly next to rootball.

CONTAINERIZED OR POTTED PLANTS

1. Auger or punch a hole, depending on size of container, for each tablet(s) being used.
2. Space holes, equal distance around the plant 2" from the container edge, 2" deep.
3. Place 1 to 2 tables per hole, depending on the size of plant, and cover hole.

During installation, we recommend using Mycor™ Tree Saver™ along with tablets.

FOREST OR FRUIT/NUT TREE SEEDLINGS:

Use 1 (7) gram tablet per 1-2 year old seedling. Place tablet two to four inches (5 to 10-cm) from the root system. If planting using a dibble bar, place tablet in closing hole.
